social clues to make smart guesses. You
can help solve mysteries with these skills!
You've been asked to solve a mystery for
Mrs. Cardenas. Her favorite puppet,
Annie, has gone missing! Use your social
smarts to follow these clues to track down
Annie and solve the mystery!

Clue 1

You walk up to a group to ask if they have seen your lost dog. You are so worried because he just got out of the backyard. You interrupt the group to ask if they have seen him.

If this is expected behavior, look for the next clue outside the third grade classroom with the teacher with curly blonde hair.

If this is unexpected behavior, look for the next clue under something that bounces in the SCORES room.

Clue 2

A classmate sometimes makes unexpected choices like yelling out or getting too close to you. You decide not to be his friend, tell him he is weird and ignore him when he tries to join you at recess.

If this is expected behavior, look for the next clue in the pod you are in when you are in second grade.

If this is unexpected behavior, look for the next clue by the back door of the largest room at Boone.

Clue 3

You really want to be friends with a classmate in your class. He tells you that yall can be friends if you buy him a toy.

If you should buy him a toy, look for the next clue outside the door of where you go to learning lab.

If you shouldn't buy him a toy because friends are free, look for the next clue outside the most musical place at Boone.

Clue 4

There's a new student in your class. She is very quiet and seems nervous. You invite her to play with you at recess.

If this is social thinking, look for the next clue where you would go to ask questions about Boone. Tell someone what we are doing and ask if they have clue number 5.

If this isn't social thinking, look for the next clue by where you would go during lunch if you were thirsty.

Clue 5

Your teacher assigns a writing assignment. You think the assignment is boring. You write one sentence and then say you are finished.

If this is expected behavior, ask someone in the office for clue number 6.

If this is unexpected behavior, check outside the class that starts with an A and has three letters.

Clue 6

At recess, you see a student saying mean things to a classmate, push him and then run away. The boy is crying. You go and tell an adult.

If this is tattling, look for the next clue where you would go if you were sick and ask if they have clue number 7.

If this is reporting, look for the next clue outside a person's room at Boone who can help you solve problems.

Clue 7

You see a classmate drawing when he should be doing math. You tell the teacher.

If this is reporting, look for the next clue outside the teacher's classroom with short blonde hair.

If this is tattling, check in the SCORES room inside something that is red and black.
